Imagine one character's closet. Describe at least five things that you would expect to find there. Why would you find these items? (Remember, many people's closets contain more than clothing!)

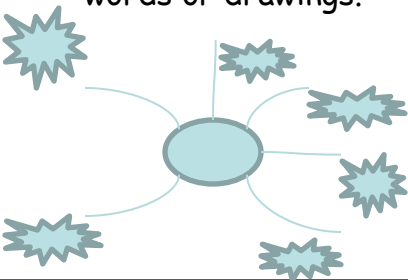
PMI Plus, Minus, Interesting

Create a mindmap of the events in the book. What happened at the beginning, middle, and end? You can use words or drawings.

Choose one scene from the book that you would like to illustrate. Why? Draw the scene from the book using lots of color and detail.



Point of View

How would the book be different if told from another character's point of view?



Decisions and Outcomes

Tell about a decision or choice made by a character. Do you think the character made a good choice? Why or why not?
