Integrated Curriculum Ants




- Science: life cycle of animals, habitats, body structure of insects

- Language Arts: shared reading (fiction and non-fiction), ant farm journals, audio-visual instruction, songs and poems.

















Letter Recognition Upon Entering Kindergarten




